THE KIDS ACROSS THE NAMOI COMMITTEE - KAN

The Namoi Catchment Management Authority (CMA), in conjunction with the Namoi Aboriginal Advisory Committee (NAAC), has developed a new and exciting project which will establish the first junior Aboriginal committee focusing on natural resource management for NSW Catchment Management Authorities. The committee will be known as the KAN (Kids Across the Namoi).

KAN members will provide comments on better ways for Namoi CMA to engage with Aboriginal youth in relation to natural resource management.

How to become a KAN Committee Member

KAN Information

- Participants will be selected from across the Namoi Catchment via an expression of interest form
- The total number of KAN members will be capped at 30
- Members must be no younger than 13 years of age and no older than 16 years of age

Namoi CMA expects to see the following outcomes from the formation of KAN:

- Engagement of Aboriginal youth in natural resource management
- Strategic plans/information provided back to Namoi CMA
- Leadership training for participants
- Sharing of catchment information
