3-P Grasses Workshop at Walgett - Palatable, Perennial and Productive!

Lower Pagan/Pian Creek Conservation Group with Namoi CMA and Queensland DPI are holding a workshop on the 17th September at 9am at the Walgett District Sporting Club to discuss palatable, perennial and productive grasses in the Walgett district.

Dr. David Phelps, Principal Scientist for Grazing Lands with DPI in Longreach will be on hand to discuss the values of 3-P grasses in the local landscape, particularly Mitchell Grass; and grazing strategies to promote 3-P grasses.

This free workshop will include sessions in identifying key features of 3-P grasses and less desirable plants in the paddock with discussions on managing for drought survival and root growth.

Landholders are also encouraged to bring along their property maps so they can discuss and develop grazing management plans and discuss ideas with other local farmers.
